

# FROM THE FIELD OF BATTLE TO THE WORLD'S STAGE: A TRIBUTE TO THE LIFE AND CAREER OF COLIN L. POWELL

**T**he entire world is shocked at the sudden death of General Powell. Powell was revered as one of America’s few remaining true patriots. A large number of global leaders took to social media to pay honour to Colin Powell’s life and legacy by posting a brief message. Powell’s journey towards the United States initiated with usual circumstances.

During his upbringing, his close-knit family surrounded him with love, support, and a nurturing atmosphere. In the military, he discovered his passion, and he’s dedicated his whole adult life to it.

He devoted his military career to upholding democratic principles while also safeguarding the country. He started off in support jobs, but his pragmatic approach and organisational skills caught the attention of those in government advisory positions.

## Early Life.

Born April 5, 1937 in New York, Colin Luther Powell to Jamaican immigrant family of Luther and Maud Powell; which was a prominent civil rights and community activist family. The South Bronx native attended the city's public schools until graduating from Morris High School in 1954 with no particular prior career goals in mind.

## Military Career.

Powell discovered his vocation in the Reserve Officers' Training Corps or ROTC while studying geology at City College of New York. He rose quickly through the ranks to become the unit's leader. Because of this encounter, his life took on structure and direction for the rest of his days. After graduating from high school, he joined the military and saw service in Vietnam in 1962–1963 and again in 1968–1969 before attending George Washington University.

He received the Purple Heart in his first year of service and the Bronze Star the following year. Powell returned to Vietnam for a second deployment in 1968-69. A helicopter accident on his second trip left him seriously wounded.

He had surgery to repair his injuries. The Soldier's Medal was presented to him because he bravely risked his life to save his fellow soldiers from the burning chopper. He has a total of 11 military honours under his belt, including the Legion of Merit for valorous service.



Powell was promoted to the rank of four-star general in April, 1989, and President George W. Bush named him the chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff later in August of the same year. He served as chairman (from August 1990 to March 1991) of the board throughout the invasion of Panama in 1989 and the Persian Gulf war and crisis and played a key role in the preparation of Desert Storm and Desert Shield. In 1993, after he left the military, many people assumed he would run for office. A non-runner up in the 1996 presidential election, he joined the Republican Party and became a voice for the country's issues.

As the first Black national security advisor, chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and secretary of state, Powell was a trailblazer as well. And although Mr. Powell had a distinguished career, he had voiced concern that he would later be remembered for just one thing which is regarding his involvement in bringing the United States into war with Iraq. However, in the midst of this war, British Prime Minister Tony Blair described Powell as having "immense talent and integrity."

Powell, according to current US President Joe Biden, "embodied the highest ideals of both warrior and diplomat and was committed to our nation's strength and security above all. Having fought in wars, he understood better than anyone that military might alone was not enough to maintain our peace and prosperity".

## **Political Career**

In 2000, for the first time in U.S. history, the United States Senate overwhelmingly approved for the first ever African American; Powell; as Secretary of State under President George W. Bush.

This was the first time an African American had ever held a position of leadership in the civil service. When Powell took office, he received accolades for running the State Department efficiently and building friendly relationships with foreign nations. To unite America's allies for military action in Afghanistan after the terrorist events on September 11, 2001, Secretary Powell played a key role.

When Powell was in office, he faced criticism for his part in helping to sell the United States on the 2003 Iraq war. He began his career in politics as a White House fellow in 1972 and quickly rose through the ranks to become an assistant to Frank Carlucci, at the Office of Management and Budget's deputy director (OMB). For a while, Powell had significant doubts about Bush's plan to attack Iraq and topple Saddam Hussein.




**Powell was confident that the Iraqi dictatorship could be kept in check via a strategy of containment. The president was told by him that a military invasion would devour Bush's first term and that if an assault were to occur, it should utilise the significant use of force and have wide international backing. He said. This kind of help would be crucial if Iraq is to be rebuilt.**

**The Bishop John T. Walker Distinguished Humanitarian Service Award, The Presidential Medal of Freedom, the Spingarn Medal, the Sylvanus Thayer Award, and the Congressional Gold Medal were among the various awards, honors and distinctions Powell won throughout his military as well as political careers. Along with these achievements, Colin Powell also penned a number of autobiographies about his life, including "It Worked for Me: In Life and Leadership" and "My American Journey."**

## Retirement

After his resignation, Powell continued to speak out on political problems, publicly criticising the Bush administration on a range of subjects. Powell joined other moderate Senate Republicans in September 2006 to support inmates at Guantanamo Bay with greater treatment as well as rights of the detainees. Powell made waves once again in 2008 when he endorsed Obama for president. The majority of Powell's retirement was likewise spent in the business world.

To assist individuals better manage their health, he joined Steve Case's Revolution Health board of directors, a health-related portal and social network. Much of Powell's life was devoted to encouraging others via his leadership abilities and life lessons. Colin Powell founded America's Promise Alliance to ensure the well-being of children and teens from all socioeconomic backgrounds and to ensure that young people have the tools they need to achieve. Powell and his wife started the organisation together.



# A TRIBUTE TO GENERAL COLIN POWELL.

Figures from across the political spectrum have paid their tributes to the first black US secretary of state and top military officer following the news. The late general and statesman was a symbol of an America on the rise.

US President Joe Biden has paid tribute to former US secretary of state Colin Powell following his death, saying he “could drive his Corvette Stingray like nobody’s business”. President Biden said he and his wife Jill were “deeply saddened” by the passing of their “dear friend and a patriot of unmatched honour and dignity”.

With the recent passing of former U.S. Secretary of State Colin Powell, it is important to take a trip down memory lane. For the most part, the age of Colin Powell was America at its strongest and most decisive. Powell, who became the highest-ranking African-American general of his generation and held the highest Cabinet position ever granted to an African-American at the time, was part of an America on the rise.

In 1983, he served as a senior military aide to Secretary of Defense Caspar Weinberger, but he was very different from his boss. While Weinberger is largely responsible for Jonathan Pollard’s fate, Powell led the successful invasion of Grenada. He also helped navigate the airstrikes in 1986 against Libyan dictator Moammar Gaddafi in retaliation for the terrorist bombing of a discotheque frequented by American soldiers stationed in West Berlin.

In 1989, as then-President George H.W. Bush’s national security advisor, he led the invasion of Panama and capture of its authoritarian ruler, Manuel Antonio Noriega, who had amassed a personal fortune through drug trafficking.

Bush later appointed him chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. In this role, he had to deal with the invasion of Kuwait by Saddam Hussein. Although reluctant to go to war—believing in the use of overwhelming force to maximize results and minimize casualties—he led the first Gulf War in 1991, using the philosophy that would come to be known as the “Powell Doctrine.”



**The Powell Doctrine led to victory by the United States in the first Gulf War and the total defeat of Saddam Hussein in the second Gulf War. Why America did not go all the way in the former is a matter of some controversy.**

**Most argue that Saddam was left in power to counterbalance the mullahs in Iran, and part of Powell's reluctance to go to war in the first place had to do with the regime in Tehran. Though the second war was a success, Bush didn't get re-elected in 1992.**

**Powell was a calm and humble soul. He might have become the first African-American president had he chosen to run as a Republican in 1996. But he didn't enter the race. He did, however, speak at the Republican National Convention in 1996 and again in 2000. In 2000, he was appointed secretary of state by President George W. Bush.**

**In 2001, he had to deal with the challenges posed by the 9/11 attacks on the World Trade Center and Pentagon. Again, he opposed a war with Iraq, but as secretary of state, he was tasked with making the case at the United Nations to do so, using the argument that Saddam possessed weapons of mass destruction. I believe he could have made the case regardless of WMD.**

In 2004, Powell resigned as secretary of state. Most believe his resignation was a direct result of getting faulty information about Saddam's WMD. Despite America's going to war against Iraq and the hullabaloo about poor intelligence regarding the WMD, Bush was re-elected.

His life stands as a testament not only to dedicated public service but also a strong belief in willingness to work across partisan division in the interests of his country. Rest in Peace Secretary Powell.

**Colin Luther Powell was born on April 5, 1937, in Harlem, New York City, New York to Jamaican immigrant parents Maud Ariel and Luther Theophilus Powell. He was educated in the New York City Public Schools and earned a bachelor’s degree in Geology from the City College of New York (CUNY) in 1958. While as a student at CUNY, Powell developed an interest in the military and joined the Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC). He was commissioned as a second lieutenant in the U.S. Army after graduation and served in the military for thirty-five years.**

**During his long military career, Powell served two tours in Vietnam in 1962 and 1968, was named National Security Advisor in 1987, served as Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff in 1989, and oversaw Operations Desert Storm and Desert Shield in 1991.**



**He was awarded a Purple Heart, a Bronze Star, the Legion of Merit, and the Defense Distinguished Service Medal. Powell retired from the military in 1993 and was confirmed as the United States Secretary of State in 2001**

**Colin was a towering figure in American military and political leadership over many years, someone of immense capability and integrity, a hugely likeable and warm personality, with a lovely and self-deprecating sense of humour.**






