# Exclusive Interview: Mrs Universe Africa finalist speaks on self improvement, giving and putting yourself first...

e had the privilege of having Dercia Josue (Mrs Universe Africa finalist) share her truth, and talk about what she has learnt along her journey. One of the things which stood out is "Nobody owes you anything". The delectable Mrs Josue recently sat down for an interview with our EU-Bureau Chief Albena A. Jones. They discussed everything from beauty therapy to her project called Smiles & Hope for Africa and lots more.

#### A-CHOICES: Tell us about yourself?

DERCIA: Entrepreneur, Lecturer and Beauty Therapist. A wife and mother of two girls, owner and founding member of Beauty by Dercia a mobile beauty Spa that focuses on restoring women's confidence. Born and bred in Mozambique, Dercia Josue like many other girls grew up running in the streets of Maputo with big dreams of representing her country through a beauty competition. She grew up with her grandmother who instilled in her the gift of giving back.

#### A-CHOICES: How did you get involved in Mrs Universe beauty pageant?

DERCIA: I grew up with a dream of one day representing my country somewhere in the diaspora... And last year I came across Mrs Universe Africa pageant which I entered, a life changing and women empowerment program, that led me to r present Africa in Women of the Universe.

A-CHOICES: How has the pageant impacted your life?

DERCIA: Well I thought being a wife, a mother and having a career was everything. After the kids all I could care about was the kids and my partner, there was no room to care for myself. The pageant came to remind me that I once had dreams and those dreams are valid, it reminded me to take care of myself, prioritize my needs before others... Which I am incredibly grateful for.

### A-CHOICES: Beside being a beauty queen, what else do you do?

DERCIA: I am a Beauty Therapist, I own a mobile beauty Spa that focuses on restoring women's confidence. Being a mother of two, I remember not having time to do my nails or even having a foot rub or massage, therefore after completing my studies I realized that there was a gap in the industry and I took the opportunity to help women like me that for various reasons couldn't leave the house, by bringing the services to them.I am also a distributor for alkali water.

A-CHOICES: What other activities fulfill your life?

DERCIA: I am a philanthropist. I grew up with my grandmother in a house full of children, which I later learnt that they were not related and from that moment on I understood the power of sharing and giving which is a legacy for my children and the generations to come. In 2020 I embarked on a project called Smiles & Hope for Africa, where I focused on keeping a girl child at school by distributing sanitary pads and toiletries to keep their dignity. I believe that the future of the African continent depends on education therefore I distribute school material to ensure that children in disadvantaged communities have access to education.

I also knit blankets and distribute them to the homeless in winter time. Once a month I cook and distribute food for the homeless. During the pandemic I was able to help families with food parcels. All the activities give me great pleasure, there's no better feeling than to see a face of someone receiving a place of food, that smile is priceless. This work has been done in South Africa, Mozambique and Malawi.

A-CHOICES: How do you feel as a global representative of Africa?

DERCIA: Very excited but at the same time nervous, as I carry the weight of not only a country but the entire continent in my shoulders, it was a big responsibility which I carry with pride and respect. I was excited about meeting people of different countries, cultures and languages. The interaction was amazing and I learned a lot.

A-CHOICES: How do you achieve balance about your personal life,work and charity activities?

DERCIA: It's difficult to achieve balance but the most important thing is your support system. I have a very supportive partner that believes in me and supports my visions and ideas, he is behind me 100% and that's the key. When it is work time I focus on work and when it is family time I give my 100%. I even switch my phone off if I have to. Once a month I do my charity drives in which I get my daughters involved as I teach them the importance of sharing and giving back.

A-CHOICES: What are your plans going forward?

DERCIA: I would like to continue reaching out to other African countries through my organization to promote the importance of education, continue creating awareness to women about domestic violence and mental health issues, which we experience on a daily basis and often most of us don't even realize.

A-CHOICES: How did you overcome the challenges throughout the journey?

DERCIA: Coming from Mozambique, and growing up with many difficulties and insecurities, I had to teach myself to be very positive, to always see the good no matter how bad the situation is.

I believe that we are on this earth for a reason, and we all have a purpose to fulfill. And sometimes our plans will fail so that God's purpose can prevail. So these beliefs are the ones that have carried me throughout the difficult and challenging times.

A-CHOICES: You said a quote the other day that still stuck with me a bit. You said 'nobody owes you anything?



DERCIA: Absolutely! The day I came across that post, it was a life changer. It says, 'no one owes you anything.' It actually came to me at a point in my life where I think I was depressed, anxious, everything. I just had these two little babies. I had my kids very close, they were both little. I was breastfeeding and it was quite difficult. And then the fact that I'm in a foreign country, I don't have a family that I can call and say, please come and help me with this one. I remember I used to wake up every morning and tell myself that no one owes me anything. And at the end of the day again I used to sit before I go to bed and tell myself that no one owes me anything.

I had to start implementing that at home. Because I know having children isn't easy. Sometimes I used to expect my husband to do so many things for me that he didn't feel that he needed to do. So I had to wake up every day and tell myself it's okay he doesn't owe me to do this. If he does it, it's great, but if he doesn't do it, it's also okay. We have so many expectations from people; we're expecting them to do things for us or to behave in a certain way. It's our responsibility to make ourselves happy, I can't expect that you'd come into my life and make me happy.

I remember after all of that, I said to myself, listen I need to learn to communicate better, I need to learn to know my values and my worth and people must know who I am, what I am to be able to understand me.

A-CHOICES: Let's flip it slightly, where does the ability to ask for help come in? Because I think it's quite important that you should also have the courage sometimes to ask for help if help is required.

DERCIA: Absolutely, we think that we are these superheroes that we can do it all but we can't do it all. So yes, we need to ask for help. People are there for so many reasons. And that's where you are able to create that connection and be able to build with others because at the end of the day, I like to believe that we are all a community, we are all one so we must be able to help one another. That's what will make the world a better place. And that's why there are people in different fields of life so that I can say I need this person to do this for me. I need that person to do that for me because people have different gifts and skills and once you know your own lane of work or gift or whatever in life, I know that if I'm in

### A-CHOICES: What's your massage to the readers?


DERCIA :Don't lose Hope, your dreams are valid. You can do and be anything you want, as long as you have focus and determination.






















### NAIRA REDESIGN - A CASE OF 'SEE FINISH'

n 26th of October 2022, the Central Bank of Nigeria (CBN) announced its decision to redesign the 200, 500 and the 1000 naira notes. The CBN governor Godwin Emefiele said the redesign is in accordance with Section two (b) of the CBN Act 2007.

The apex bank said currency management has continued to face daunting challenges in recent times and have continued to grow with consequences for the integrity of the bank and the country.

The primary challenges the bank noted were, significant hoarding of banknotes by members of the public with statistics revealing that over 80 percent of currency in circulation are outside the vaults of commercial banks. Worsening shortage of clean and fit banknotes and increasing ease and risk of counterfeiting which is evident with security reports.

The CBN believes that the increased development in photographic technology and advancements in printing devices has increased the rate of counterfeiting which is now done with ease and predominantly with the higher denominations of N500 and N1000.

According to global standards, the Central Bank is to redesign, produce and circulate new local legal tender every five to eight years yet the naira has not been redesigned in the last 20 years, the CBN revealed.

The CBN further stated that, "On the basis of these trends, problems, and facts, and in line with Sections 19, subsections a and b of the CBN Act 2007, the management of the CBN sought and obtained the approval of President Muhammadu Buhari to redesign, produce, and circulate new series of banknotes at N200, N500, and N1,000 levels.

"In line with this approval, we have finalized arrangements for the new currency to begin circulation from December 15, 2022. The new and existing currencies shall remain legal tender and circulate together until January 31, 2023 when the existing currencies shall cease to be legal tender."

Nigerians have expressed divergent views on the redesign of the naira notes, while some are insisting it is long overdue, others feel it won't make any significant difference. Taking to their different social media accounts to express their stance on the announcement made by the apex bank, some believe it is another avenue for government officials to launder more funds.

Nigerians anticipated the said redesign as they wondered what the new design would look like while hoping that the CBN would not use photos of any current government official. They went further to create amateur notes with photos of some comedians to mimic the pending redesign.

Meanwhile, the CBN had said it would release the newly redesigned note to the general public from December 15, 2022. "In line with this approval, we have finalized arrangements for the new currency to begin circulation from December 15, 2022. The new and existing currencies shall remain legal tender and circulate together until January 31, 2023 when the existing currencies shall cease to be legal tender."

However, President Muhammadu Buhari on Tuesday, November 23, 2022 unveiled the newly redesigned naira banknotes at the presidential villa ahead of the release in December.

Was there a redesign? No. There was rather a repainting. The features of the old notes remained untouched. What the CBN did is a typical case of 'see finish'. See finish is a Nigerian slang for over familiarity, when you become too familiar with someone or a thing, abuse is most times inevitable because you already know the reaction that would come.



One Feranmi on Twitter with the handle @feranmi captured my thoughts exactly, "I am just wondering what this government takes Nigerians for, because how can you just pour ink on naira notes and claim that you have redesigned it and even dragged the President into the charade of shame.

This is not a redesign; it's a colour change. All design, font type and position are the same. Please if I'm wrong, a professional designer should correct me. All I can see is colour change."

On second thought, could we be overreacting? In its press briefing, the CBN governor said the redesign is according to global best practice, could it be that when it comes to the CBN and issues surrounding banknotes the term 'design' is entirely a different thing?

Just as Feranmi noted in the tweet, every feature including the font size of the banknotes that were 'redesigned' did not change. I think the federal government and the CBN needs to educate us on what redesign means in the banking and minting sector in other to save us the stress next time.

But we have been bothered about the redesigning, oh; sorry I mean recolouring or repainting, anyone you prefer; we have not discussed how much it cost the CBN to change the colours of these bank notes.

I think we need to divide ourselves by two, the first half will continue to help us understand redesigning according to the CBN, while the second half will inquire how much it cost the CBN to change the colours of the naira notes.

I think Nigerians deserve to know if the ink for the recolouring was imported or not and how much it cost the apex bank to make this change. But again, the ministry of finance had earlier distanced itself from the said redesign. The Minister of Finance, Budget and National Planning Zainab Ahmed said the CBN did not carry her ministry along in its plan to and roll out new N200, N500 and N1000.

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"We were not consulted at the ministry of finance by the CBN on the planned naira redesigning and cannot comment on it as regards merits or otherwise," the minister told Senators at the senate chamber. Who then do we ask for the budget of the 'redesigning'?

Scared of what was going on and not having a mother daughter talk she approached her close friend at school regarding her situation. She asked her friend if she had the same occurrences in her life. Her friend whose mother was a medical doctor made her understand that at that age it was not normal to have such a large number of discharges Marta had said she experienced.

It doomed Marta that something strange was happening to her at night. After which she constantly had terrible nightmares and found it difficult to sleep, this then affected the once A student. Her grades started dropping drastically, worried that her life was shattering before her eyes. She decided to get long naps during the day and stay awake at night.

Marta desperately wanted to know what was going on with her body and because she only noticed the presence of the discharge when she was up in the mornings or when she went to use the toilet at the dead of night.

At 03:00 am on the eve of her 11th birthday Marta was deeply troubled, she wondered why her situation was the way it was. Afraid that her life has changed forever, battling with insomnia, she got a break when sleep showed its strength. When she was about to close her eyes, her uncle, hoping that Marta was fast asleep, snuck into her room, pulled his pants and forced himself on the little girl.

Marta tried to scream but her uncle gagged her and deprived her of calling for help. When he was done having his way with her, he threatened her that if she ever told anyone what has transpired that she would no longer have a home, care and love of her parents. He also told her how she would be slut shamed and would be driven out of school which will make her life completely useless. The once happy and vibrant girl became withdrawn and less active, she lost trust for people, at a time she felt suicidal. Till date Marta lives in fear and is scared of men.

## MAN JUMPED FROM BEDROOM WINDOW IN EXETER TO ESCAPE POLICE

haun Roberts tried to speed away from police in a car but crashed into railings. Roberts has been jailed for drug offences.

A drug supplier jumped out of the window and tried to run away when

A drug supplier jumped out of the window and tried to run away when police raided a house in Exeter. Shaun Roberts made several trips delivering heroin and cocaine from London to the South West.

But when police executed a warrant at an address in the city he leapt from a bedroom window in a futile bid to escape. He tossed wraps of heroin in the garden as he ran but was arrested at the scene and his involvement was linked through DNA, car movements and phone evidence.

Roberts was part of a county lines gang operating from a base in Arena Park in 2018 but has only just been sentenced at court for conspiracy to supply class A heroin and cocaine. Two co-defendants are still to be dealt with.

Prosecutor Mr Peter Coombe said Roberts made seven return trips to Devon from London in May and June of 2018 using a hire car. He also visited Newquay in Cornwall. Police executed the warrant after seeing suspicious drug dealing activity involving a number of people and known local users.

After Roberts' arrest police linked him to 11 wraps of heroin and 52 wraps of cocaine found in the bedroom. There was also more than £1,000 in cash.

When police analysed his phone they found bulk messages advertising drugs for sale had been sent. The prosecutor said Roberts had control of the phone and a prominent role in the operation.

Roberts, aged 25, also admitted a charge of dangerous driving relating to an incident in Birmingham when he 'panicked' and tried to outrun police but ended up crashing against railings.

Mr Tristan Chaize, defending, said Roberts, of Greyhound Road, London, was just a courier acting under the instructions of others. Judge Timothy Rose said the offences were too serious for a suspended sentence. He disqualified him from driving for 18 months.


In the interview, transcribed by L'Équipe, Yeo Moriba talked about Paul's recovery stating, "Paul is starting to recover little by little psychologically."

She detailed the aftermath of Paul's alleged kidnapping and how affected he was. She stated that, "This affair tormented him. He didn't tell us right away that he had been kidnapped. Nobody knew, his brothers weren't aware either."

It was clear from her responses that she felt for both of her sons as any mother would. Even with the allegations against her son Mathias, she defended him saying, "Mathias was manipulated, threatened... I'm worried about him."

The World Cup winner's mother claimed that Mathias' alleged actions were done under duress. She explained in detail, "He acted under threat, he is not like that. I know him. I can swear. Before leaving for Guinea, I spoke with him once.

I told him he shouldn't do the videos, but I felt he was taken aback. Mathias is nice. For me, my two sons are victims and that torments me . . . I'm worried about him. He's my son. He doesn't know banditry."

ill Smith has responded to criticism over his new film being released so soon after he slapped Chris Rock at the Academy Awards in March. Will Smith has acknowledged that his fans may not be "ready" to watch him on screen in the upcoming film "Emancipation." The drama is the 54-year-old's first project following his controversial slapping of Chris Rock at the Oscars earlier this year.

It marks his first project to be released since the controversy at this year's Oscars ceremony, when he stormed on stage to confront Chris Rock over a joke regarding wife Jada Pinkett Smith.He subsequently announced his resignation from the Academy, while bosses confirmed he would serve a 10-year ban from all Oscars-related events.

Asked about some people's feelings that they would struggle to watch the new film so soon after the incident, he told Jake Hamilton on his Jake's Takes YouTube Channel: 'I feel like that's the type of thing that you would say before you sit in the movie theatre.

'I think the work that [director Antoine Fuqua] has done, and all of the artists involved with this film, I would hope that the importance of the story and the importance of Peter rise above those feelings and emotions.'

He described the period since the Oscars as 'difficult', but urged filmgoers not to 'penalise' the rest of the cast and crew who have worked hard on the project. He added: 'It certainly has been a difficult last few months. And I would just hope that these spectacular artists who have come together on this project, I would hope that they would not be penalised for a few horrific moments of indiscretion on my part.'

Meanwhile, Will also reflected on his experience working on the movie, and the lessons he learned from his character.


'It was interesting that the playing of Peter led into this last few months of my life. There was a new idea that came through, the ability to have an open heart in hell, is the only way to be here,' he said.

That is the giant, spiritual lesson that I took away from Peter. It's the lesson of all of our holy books. Can we have an open heart in hell? For me, when I look at Peter and when I see humans who have learned how to do that, that is the north star for me.






## 'LEAVE MEGHAN ALONE!' STORMZY RAPS ABOUT DUCHESS IN MOVING SONG

# THE LONDONER CHOSE TO SPEND HIS YOUTUBE FORTUNE PAYING OFF HIS PARENTS £40,000 OF DEBT FROM TWO BUST OFF LICENCES

rjun Yogan has taken full advantage of the surge in popularity of anime A millennial YouTuber who used to struggle to make ends meet now earns £30,000-a-week from his videos.

Straight after graduating university in 2017, Arjun Yogan worked for Direct Line in his boyhood bedroom at his parent's house in Ilford, London.

He had to give up half of his modest salary to help pay off his parents' £40,000 worth of debt after two of their corner shops went bankrupt.

The 27-year-old data analyst had "no money" and saw no way out of poverty for both him and his parents - that was until he began uploading videos more frequently to his anime YouTube account.

Arjun Yogan was earning a modest salary at Direct Line before he hit the big time "I didn't have any big ambition to create a YouTube channel that would make me rich at that point," he said.

"It was just about getting £600-a-month off it, so I could afford to rent a box room in Bromley.

"By that point, my mother was ill and my dad was her carer, so neither of them could work and I needed to support them. They were on benefits and life was hard. "I couldn't see the point in working constantly but still having no money, so I knew I had to find alternative revenue streams.

"I've loved anime since I was a kid after I got hooked on Dragon Ball Z when I was seven and I used to draw my favourite characters.

Yogan said he started the channel at university where it remained fairly dormant.

"Initially, I used to give these to friends and family but I set up a YouTube channel at university and had kept it ticking over in the background.

"It wasn't really making me any money but I knew there was a huge appetite for anime and I thought I'd try and cash in on that."

Once he finished uni, he spent much of his free time focussing on the channel, slogging away until 2am every day creating content and seeing his following grow to 130,000 subscribers.

By that point, he was earning the same amount as at his job Direct Line so he quit.

He can now afford lavish holidays and drives a new BMW

"It was exhausting and I was burning the candle at both ends with no guarantee it would pay off," he said.

"But I have always had a passion for anime and so in some ways it didn't feel like work. It was more of a release from the rat race.

Since leaving the job in December 2018, Arjun has cleared his parents' debts entirely and gone on to build an even larger following with his channel attracting more than 30 million views in two years.

He has also swapped the boxroom for a two-bed penthouse apartment in south London and even drives a £50,000 BMW, thanks to his 800,000 subscribers.

"I am earning currently in excess of £120,000-a-month now from YouTube, sponsors and Patreon earnings combined," he said.

"Even though I could be living a lavish lifestyle and jet setting all over the world, a lot of that doesn't interest me.

"I just see it as superficial and fickle.

"Instead I have been saving and investing the large majority of it.

"I might spend it one day but I can't see the point of wasting it on things that mean nothing."



Shortly before his death, he had held the Sammie Okposo Praise Party in Lagos on November 4, 2022. A day before his death, he had posted a throwback video of the concert on his Instagram page. In the video, he could be seen leading the congregation in an intense praise and worship session.

Meanwhile, tributes have not stopped pouring in for the singer. A veteran actor, Richard Mofe-Damijo, posted a video of both of them together. He added the caption, "This was exactly a month ago in the US. We spent two weeks together and fellowshipped as men. Ate, drank and, as I'm known to do, teased you. Toks or Jedi, would drive you to me and we would spend the entire day together."







Burna Boy whose real name is Damini Ebunoluwa Ogulu, is a three-time Grammy nominee and has won other notable awards.






It was learnt that the 31-year-old songwriter was driving in his newly acquired vehicle when he was attacked and killed.

# KEVIN JOHNSON MAKES NO FINAL WORDS AND REFUSES LAST MEAL

convicted murderer refused to give a final statement and turned down the offer of a last meal in the hours before his execution on Tuesday as protests continued against his sentence Death row murderer Kevin Johnson gave "no statement" and declined a final meal before his execution for killing a police officer.

The 37-year-old was given the lethal injection on Tuesday evening at the state prison in Bonne Terre, Missouri after he was denied a last minute appeal by the US Supreme Court.

His 19-year-old daughter was also refused permission to watch the execution as in Missouri witnesses need to be aged 21.

Johnson was handed the death penalty for the 2005 murder of officer William McEntee from Kirkwood Police Department, who he targeted in a revenge killing after alleging he did not do enough to save his 12-year-old brother's life.

Johnson's legal team did not challenge his guilt, but claim racism played a role in the decision to seek the death penalty and in the jury's decision to sentence him. In addition to refusing to provide a statement, a non-mandatory element of the procedure before execution, Johnson also refused the offer of a final meal.

In a first for modern executions in Missouri, Johnson was not alone in the execution room, and was joined spiritual advisor Reverend Darryl Gray at his side. The two men are reported to have spoken until the drug was administered. The Reverend read from the Bible as Johnson shut his eyes, with his body movement ceasing shortly afterwards. After he was executed, he then continued reading from the

Bible and praying while patting Johnson's shoulder. Recalling the scene in the execution room, he said: "We read scripture and had a word of prayer.

"He apologised again. He apologized to the victim's family. He apologised to his family. He said he was looking forward to seeing his baby brother. And he said he was ready."


Johnson's 19-year-old daughter Khorry Ramey had pleaded with authorities to witness the execution - but state law prohibits anyone under 21 from observing the process.


His sentencing had prompted protests in the days and hours leading up to his execution, with many supporting the lawyer's assertions of racism and opposing the use of the death penalty.

A group of around 30 people could be seen protesting outside the Governor's Mansion in Jefferson City, Missouri on Tuesday.


Some of those in attendance held up a large sign that read "Stop State Murder" while Capitol police guarded the gateway to the mansion.

A similar sized group was also seen in St Louis, where a demonstration is staged outside the Civil Courts Building.



The so called friends sickenly also recorded the evidence. They couldn't call an ambulance, they actually left her and flew back to America and told her mum she had alcohol poisoning.



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
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






































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








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
