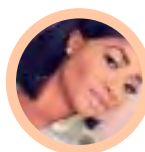

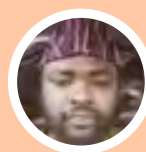

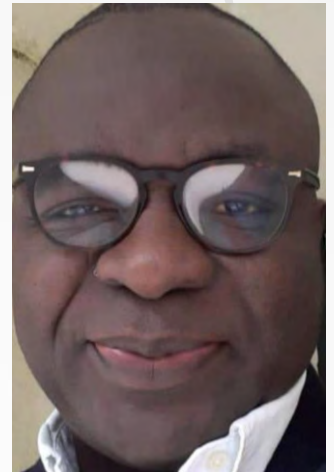
He suffered depression and mental breakdowns which was evident in some of his lyrics. He was a young shining star that suffered immense misery.

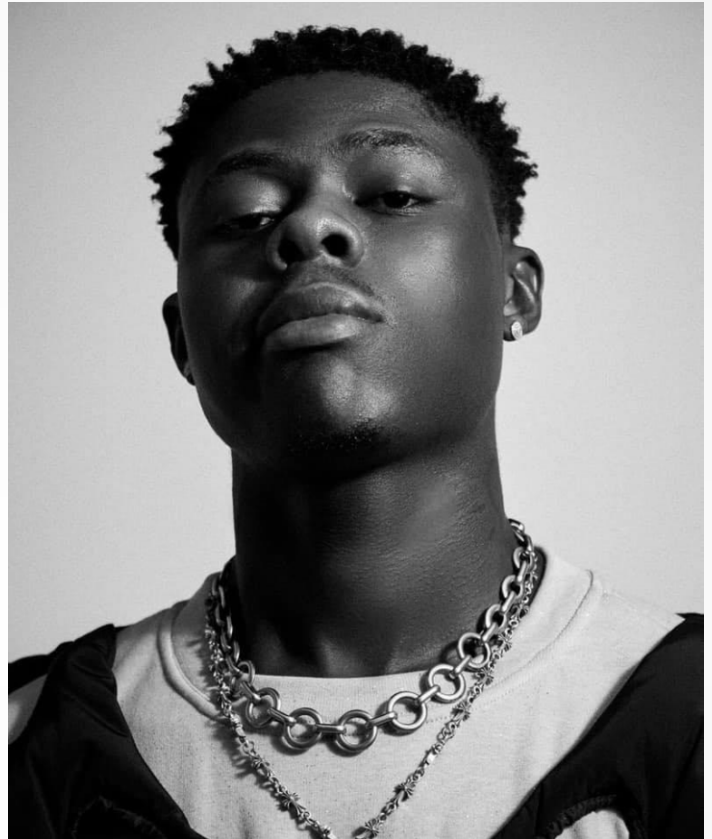


Death of MohBad

The Nigerian music scene is still in shock over the death of popular rapper and singer Mohbad, known as Ilerioluwa Oladimeji Aloba. The sad news has left fans and the entertainment industry deeply saddened. The news of Mohbad's death was confirmed by a close associate, bringing immense sorrow to the music world. He was celebrated for songs like "KPK" and had a significant impact on the industry. On 12 September 2023, Nigerian musician MohBad allegedly died of an ear infection in Lagos, at the age of 27. The nurse who administered the Tetanus vaccine on him was reportedly arrested and found to be an unlicensed nurse on 19 September 2023 by the Lagos State Police Command. Mohbad recently talked about his album to the Guardian, saying, "I feel so good; I feel blessed because it wasn't that really easy putting all that music together for the progress. What I heard about the project after dropping makes me feel good, makes me feel great." I

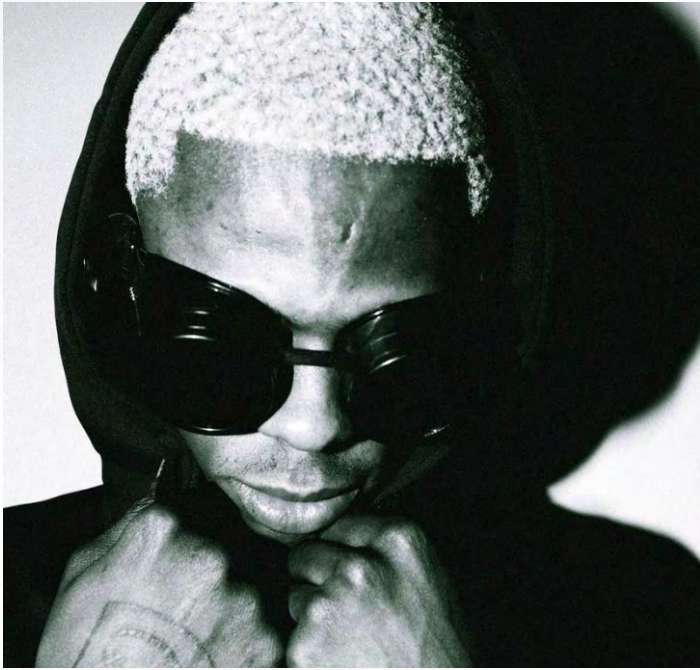


think this guy just wanted to be decent and do his music successfully without being rough or getting involved in dirty stuff that a lot of people do in the industry. You can tell he had a warm spirit.

I chose to take my time to really understand what is happening regarding Mohbad's death and it's so painful that the majority of us only listen to beats and sounds in music but

never pay attention to the lyrics. In this act, Mohbad mimics the late American rapper Tupac, whose death at 26 in 1996 has immortalised his art and himself. His words and lyrics today are still being fetched and scrutinised with social and philosophical lenses and are branded inspired. He, too, like Mohbad, died in controversial circumstances, and 27 years later, his murder has not been conclusively resolved.

Mohbad is mysterious, there is just something about him. He's a whole lot of light that many tried to dim but something about light is you can't kill it even when it's dead. The guy died and became the biggest phenomenon in the Nigerian music space everyone forgot about Davido, Wizkid, Burna Boy and even legends started getting cancelled. The kind of media content, news

articles, videos and gossip pieces that have been churned out about the late artiste has been frankly overwhelming. There have been nationwide protests demanding justice for him. Almost every YouTuber, blogger and wannabe gossip columnist is coming up with 'scoops' that are getting wilder by the day – he was poisoned, he was murdered, his wife was unfaithful, his son was not his, he was a saint.

In his long-lasting feud with his fellow artiste, Naira Marley, Mohbad had apparently filed a petition to the police accusing a certain Sam Larry Elegushi and others of attacking him at a video shoot, armed with weapons, inflicting injuries on him and damaging property worth millions. This was in June 2023. Three months later, the artiste turns up dead. Did the police act on his complaints about threats to his life? Did they investigate his claims? The police failed Mohbad. The only way to heal the pains of the family and state the rage of the justice mob is for the investigations to be speedy, efficient and transparent. After all, rumours thrive in the absence of valid information.

After much reflection on Mohbad's death and the reactions that followed, I came to the following conclusion. The

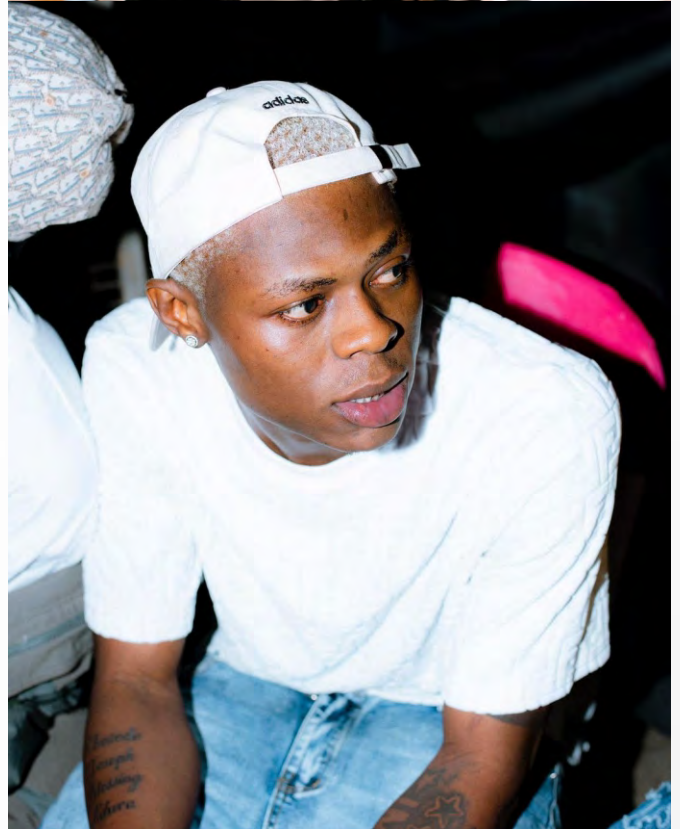
poisons meant to kill you, learn to turn down some offers no matter how juicy they appear.

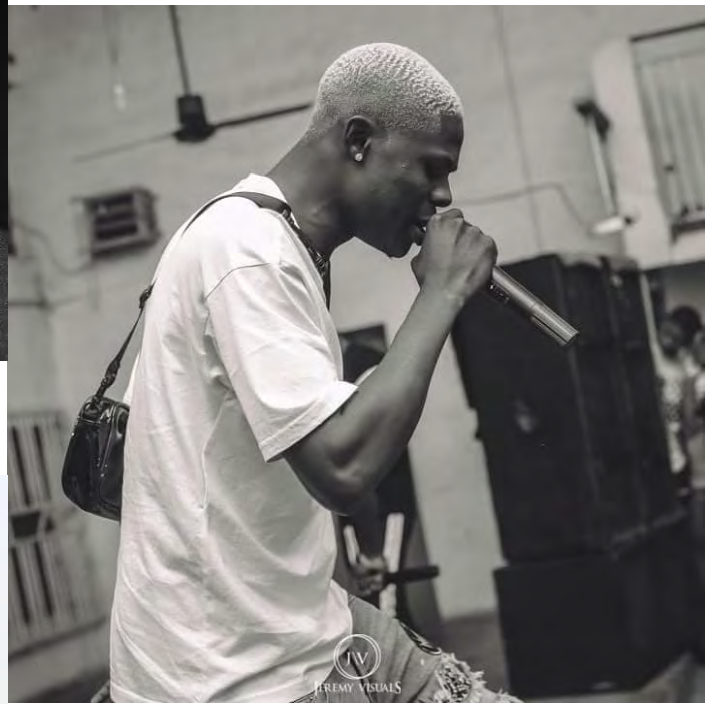

remember him for his talent, for his spirit. Let's celebrate his life... Rest in Heavenly Perfect Peace - IMOLE.





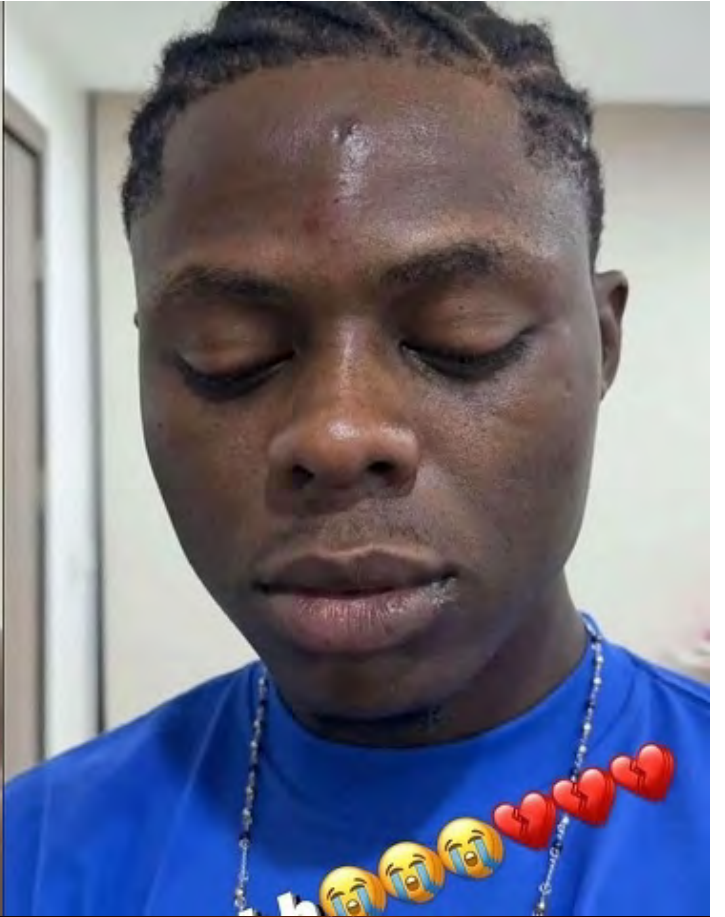

Mohbad: A rising star cut short

Twenty seven years ago, the Aloba family welcomed a baby boy on June 8, 1996 and they named him Ilerioluwa Oladimeji Aloba. The young boy grew to love music and started singing at a very young age. That love for music formed the path of his life and destiny. After graduating from high school, Ilerioluwa who is now popularly known as Mohbad or Imole, started producing cover songs which he uploaded on the internet. With consistency and determination, he soon became popular and was later signed into the Marlian Records in 2019 by popular artist, Naira Marley.

He quickly rose to prominence with his hit song KPK (KO po ke) and his unique fusion of pop, Afrobeat, and hip-hop. His fans loved him for his skill as a musician and songwriter. His journey was smooth, or so we thought until in 2022 when he exited the Marlian Records on grounds of unpaid royalties. Having exited the label on a rough note,

it severed the relationship he had with his former boss, Naira Marley. Their open misunderstanding took a new dimension when Mohbad alleged in 2022, that his former boss should be held responsible if he died or anything had happened to him.

He said in a live Instagram video that: "Everybody in the whole world please help me, if I die woh na Marlian music and Naira Marley kill me.

"Abeg if I die like this, God, please help me. Look at all these people sha my God will never fuck me up, never," he said. Sadly, after a year, Mohbad mysteriously died on September 12, 2023. He was buried a day later however, his body was later exhumed for an autopsy after an investigation into the cause of his death was opened in Lagos.

His death had spark several protest around many cities in Nigeria and around the globe with candle lighting held in his honour.

The late rapper, singer, and songwriter was best known for his hit songs

“Ponmo,” “Peace,” “Beast and Peace,” “Sorry”, “Feel Good,” and “KPK (Ko Por Ke)” (You Will Always Be Remembered) with Rexxie, which was nominated three times for The Headies awards 2022.

It is clear that recovering from his sudden death would take a long while and would also be a hard one for his fan base and the many sympathisers around the world.

While we wait for the investigation to be concluded we pray his young soul finds rest and he finds justice even in death.

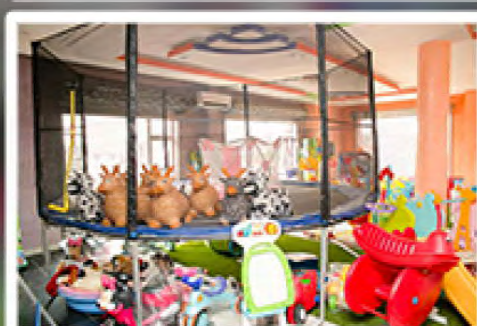
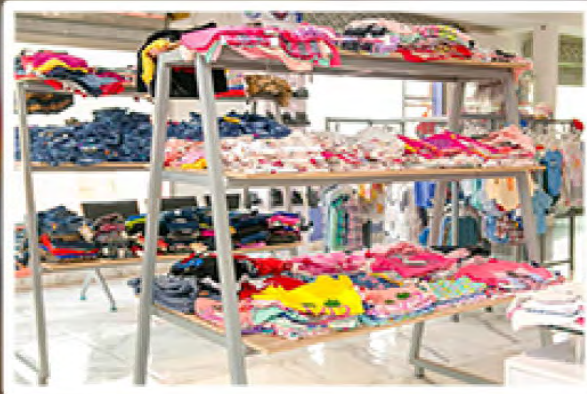
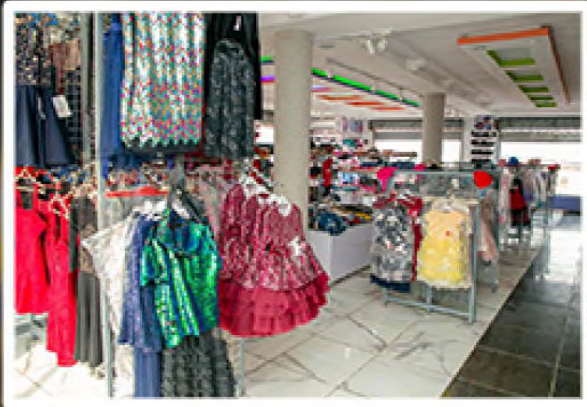
